Coastguard/ Helicopter Procedure	CM explained to the meeting that there is a specific procedure for the coast guard helicopter to be sent out to the island. Those needing assistance should call 111 in the first instance to be assessed. If a helicopter or lifeboat is then deemed necessary, 111 personnel will initiate the coast guard transport. There are 3 recognised landing sites in Canna. If a helicopter or lifeboat is on its way to Canna, please contact GMK or CM for further assistance.
